Book Of Memories Homemade Clothes, Oil Lamps, Hand-Picking Cotton

Mary Allene Turlington Honeycutt, born in March of 1913, has a fortune in memories of growing up in Coats. From the days of hand picking cotton in the fields all day and plucking feathers from geese to make beds and pillows to seeing the first talking movie, she has put her memories in black and white to pass down to generations to come. Her 53-page book, "Remembering the Past: Memories of Growing Up," was published by Work/Shop Press Inc. in Atlanta in March 2004.

The 91-year-old Mrs. Honeycutt worked for nine years, compiling memories for the book by

hand and by tape recorder. Her oldest daughter, Carol Honeycutt Hollahan, transcribed her work. Mrs. Honeycutt is the youngest of 15 children, and the only one still alive. She said she wrote this book of memoirs for the younger generations and the ones to come.

"I did it for the children and the grandchildren," she said.

Mrs. Honeycutt said that it's important to her that her family knows about their ancestors and where they came from, and that when she passes away, no one will be left to tell them. The book starts off with memories of her early childhood growing up with so many brothers and sisters and continues through her married years.

"We had a very good childhood," she said. "We made our own toys and we played with each other."

The book recites memories of stories her grandparents told her, including one about hiding food and wagon wheels in a cave in the well from invading Yankee soldiers during the Civil War. Mrs. Honeycutt gave a first-hand account in the story of everyday chores such as using an iron that had to be heated on the stove, filling oil lamps because there was no electricity and lowering foods that could spoil into the well where it was cool in the summer time.

Her mother, the oldest girl of 17 children, made all the clothes for her husband and 15 children, loom the fabric at home from cotton and dyeing it different colors with different colored leaves. She recalled seeing "Danny Boy," the first talking movie, on a grade school trip to Raleigh.

The book follows her life through the Great Depression, during which she was married to James Honeycutt. Struggling at first, Mr. Honeycutt was lucky to find a job that paid \$12.12 per week at the time. In 1950 they were able to build their own home, the home in which Mrs. Honeycutt still lives in Coats. It then cost \$6,500 to build. Across the street is the nearly dilapidated house where she was born and grew up.

"I used to pick cotton right where this house sits," Mrs. Honeycutt said. "All of this land around here was ours, and it was all tended with mules and plows."

Although Mrs. Honeycutt vividly remembers her past, she is not living it. More active than some adults half her age, she takes water aerobics classes three times a week at Campbell University, volunteers by delivering meals at senior centers, and spends long hours gardening and tending to her yard every day.

In addition, traveling the world has been a hobby of hers for the past several years. She has been to countries such as France, England, Germany, Korea and Argentina, journeying with her two daughters. When she was younger, she said, she didn't have the time or the money to travel, so she's making up for it now. Although she travels, she always returns to Harnett County.

"This is home," she said. "I've never had any desire to live anywhere else."

With more than 50 copies of her book printed, she said she'll have to print more soon.

"Everyone who has read it has wanted a copy," she said. "I still have more people who want them."

Geared toward her family, she plans to distribute more copies at her next reunion, and has donated a copy for display to the Centennial Committee in Coats to keep her memories alive.

Military duty leaves Turlington with a love of aviation

CLINTON - Henry L. Turlington, better known as "Fes" Turlington, seems to think his experiences during World War II don't deserve a story.

"I didn't shoot at anybody, and nobody shot at me," Turlington said during an interview at his home in Coharie Acres.

Turlington and others may forget that there were hundreds of thousands of men and women who were never in combat during World War II and that there were many who never went overseas. This writer, who has interviewed dozens of World War II veterans, can attest that, although not all who served during World War II were heroes - some never were in combat, some never went overseas - without exception everyone has had an interesting story to tell.

(The National World War II Memorial, now under construction in Washington, will honor veterans, whether they served in combat or not, and will even have a registry of non-uniformed people who served on the home front.)

Although it may be a cliché to say, "They served, they did their duty," the fact is that Turlington did just that, first enlisting in the Army Reserve in early 1943 but then shortly volunteering for the Army Air Corps, where he served until 1946.

And Turlington continues to be supportive of the military and its history, especially if it has anything to do with aviation.

One of the things of which he is most proud, he says, is his association with the National Air and Space Museum and its Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center at Washington Dulles International Airport. He has a plaque which reads, in part, "In grateful acknowledgement of your outstanding support to create the National Air and Space Museum Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center, Sgt. Henry L. Turlington, AAC, is hereby inducted as an Air and Space 'Friend' of the Udvar-Hazy Center."

The plaque further tells Turlington that his name will be inscribed on the National Aviation Space Exploration Wall of Honor "as a permanent testament to your commitment and passion for aviation and space exploration." The award was certified Jan. 10, 2002.

(The Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center will open to the public Dec. 15. Ultimately, nearly 100 percent of the museum's collection will be on view, including the more than 200 aircraft and 135 space artifacts, current displays in the museum on the National Mall and objects on loan.)

Turlington, during the interview at his home, chuckled before saying that his first interest in aviation may have been when he, at age 20, was slogging on the ground at Fort McClellan,

Ala., as an infantryman trainee and observed planes passing overhead, its occupants mud-free.

"I knew that was the place to be," Turlington said. "Besides, I didn't know how to dig."

Two decades before his experience with Alabama dirt, Turlington was born in Clinton, in 1922, to F.L. and Callie Turlington. His mother was also a Turlington, from Benson. He graduated from Clinton High School in 1939, and attended Duke University before enlisting in the Army Reserve in January of 1943. Three months later, he was on active duty, beginning April 3, at Fort Bragg and from there was sent to Fort McClellan.

"I found I was in a machinegun outfit," said Turlington, "and I found out that I wouldn't live if I stayed in such an outfit." Then, he began to think about the planes overhead, heard about the Army Air Corps, quickly enlisted, in July, and was accepted.

"I was first sent to the University of Alabama, in Tuscaloosa, for what they called college training detachment," Turlington remembers. He was there for about three months, undergoing what he termed 10-hour-day flight training.

"But I began to find that I didn't really want to fly," Turlington said.

Nevertheless, Turlington found himself in San Antonio, Texas, there for the military to learn if he could make a pilot. He couldn't, both the military and Turlington concluded, so he was sent to Kessler Field in Mississippi, to be trained as an engineer gunner for a B-24 bomber. This was in January 1944.

In July 1944 Turlington found himself at Tyndall Field, Florida, undergoing gunnery school. In January 1945 he was at Westover Field in Massachusetts for a few days of crew classification then it was on to Chatham Field, Savannah, Ga., to undergo combat B-24 training.

Overseas, World War II was still in full force - in Europe the Battle of the Bulge was raging while in the Pacific the battles for islands were reaching a crescendo.

So, in training camps all over the nation, men were being prepared to be shipped overseas, Turlington among them. But, for Turlington that didn't happen. In May, when the war in Europe ended, his training was shifted from B-24 to B-29, the latter having become a mainstay of bombing missions in the Pacific.

Before that, though, something occurred that Turlington has never forgotten, not even the most minute detail. The B-24 he was on crashed and its pilot was killed.

His name, the pilot, was Pete, Turlington said: Peter J. Curato, from Hartford, Conn., of Italian descent.

"Pete's wife was from Jonesboro, Arkansas," Turlington related. "and she was there while we were in Georgia. So, Pete, who was an instructor pilot, decided he would fly to Jonesboro and fly over his wife's home. I kept telling him we didn't have enough gas, I kept telling him to put more gas in each tank, but he wouldn't listen."

Anyway, says Turlington, the B-24 took off, with six aboard, Turlington occupying the position of engineer gunner, and flew to Arkansas.

"We buzzed around her house a few times, and then headed back toward Savannah," Turlington recalls. When the engines began sputtering for lack of fuel, he said, the plane had already passed a suitable landing site, but Curator turned the big bomber around, hoping to land it safely.

"It was a beautiful, moonlit night, about two a.m.," Turlington remembers, when Curato told the crew it was bailout time.

"We all had had some parachute training," said Turlington, although he, himself, had made no practice jumps, not even from a tower, since there were none at the base.

"They had told us what to do, like when to snap the chest pack - they said to snap up instead of down, but I snapped down instead of up - and so my parachute ring was on the left instead of the right.

"And I didn't count to ten, either."

Recalling that he was the second one out of the plane, Turlington remembers that the plane was so low, about 1,200 feet, that before landing he could see the plane burning on the ground, about five miles away.

As he neared the ground, Turlington said, he was sure he was going to hit a big pine tree, but instead landed in a plowed field, "with a great 'kaboom.'"

"Some guys in a pickup picked us up and then we went to the plane, which landed about a hundred yards from a house," said Turlington. About the biggest piece of the plane intact was about the size of a sofa, he said.

About 5 a.m., said Turlington, medics came with an ambulance.

Pete didn't make it. As the pilot, he would have been the last to bail out.

"The plane dropped like a rock," said Turlington. "Pete had no chance."

Only a few hours earlier, Curato had seen his wife for the last time, waving from the front porch of a house in Jonesboro, Ark.

Because of his jump and survival, Turlington became a member of the Caterpillar Club. He explains: "At that time, anybody in the service became a member of the Caterpillar Club if they survived an emergency parachute jump from an aircraft."

When Japan surrendered in September, 1945, Turlington was still at Chatham Field, but was soon transferred to the Overseas Replacement Depot in Greensboro, to work as a payroll clerk. He was there when he was discharged in February 1946, with the rank of sergeant.

After his discharge Turlington returned to Clinton to work with his father at Turlington

Lumber Co. His father died in 1951 and Turlington and his brother, Thomas, ran the operation until 1960, when Turlington sold his share to Thomas.

Several business ventures have occupied Turlington's time since leaving the lumber business, including operating the Clinton Sports Center in downtown Clinton, until 1972; with partners buying and running a potato chip vending franchise based in Myrtle Beach; selling real estate along southeastern beaches; and, from 1981 until 1987 when he retired, serving as an economic developer for Sampson County.

Turlington remembers that it was during his tenure when developer offices first came to be located at the Clinton-Sampson Airport. "It was," he said, "an interesting and rewarding job."

Turlington has been active in politics since 1960, when he became enthusiastic about the campaign of John Kennedy. He remembers going to Greenville to see and hear Kennedy during a campaign swing through North Carolina.

Since then, he has served as Third Congressional District Young Democrats Club chairman, president of the Sampson County Young Democrats and chairman of the Sampson County Democratic Party. He has also hosted the visits of various state officials and political candidates.

Since 1952 Turlington has been married to the former Ann Tyson, of Roseboro. They are the parents of three sons. Lee lives in Oregon, Ed in Raleigh and Ken in Texas.

Turlington remembered as a 'gentle soul'

He is described as a man who always stood up for what he believed in and, according to his friends, what he stood for was generally always right.

Thomas Eli Turlington, a current Clinton city councilman, former chairman of the Sampson County Board of Commissioners, veteran of the U.S. Air Force and long-standing church member, died Tuesday, May 16, 2000.

Albert Kaleel, a friend since childhood and a fellow city councilman, said the loss of Turlington will be felt both on a personal level and on an official level as well.

"He was a good councilman. I know Clinton's losing a good citizen. He was an asset to this community and we're going to miss him."

Turlington was only five months into his third four-year term on the City Council, having just been re-elected last November. According to city manager Tommy Combs, Turlington was a councilman who "looked after his district and always thought of other people."

"He was a gentle soul," Combs said, "and was the kind of person that you could disagree with and still remain friends." That same approachable personality could be described as charisma, Combs continued.

"He had a presence about him ... he was a leader and people paid attention to him when he talked.

"Sometimes you would think that he may be against a project, but all he was doing was gathering information." Combs explained that Turlington would ask questions to which he might already know the answer, but felt it was a question that needed to be raised; one that others needed to hear the answer to. "I really did like him. He was an outstanding councilman and he certainly had knowledge and concern for Clinton," Combs stated.

Clinton Mayor A.E. Kennedy agreed that Turlington was a councilman who stood up for what he believed in.

"Tommy was very fair in his thinking; he was very conservative too, but when it came down to it and something he felt like was good for the city, Tommy would go all out for it there, regardless of the cost," Kennedy said. "When he made up his mind he wanted something done, he didn't quit until it was there. He stuck with it and fought for it."

Whether it was in a business setting, in council chambers or on the golf links, Turlington was known for his outgoing personality, his friendliness to every person.

"He knew no strangers," said Dr. Bill Peak, one of Turlington's many golfing buddies. "He was the most affable, friendly person, especially to people he first met or didn't know. He always gave a good handshake to people, told them his name and wanted to know theirs."

"He was obviously an astute business man and was set in his ways in what he thought was right and wrong. And," Peak added, "he was usually right."

For Peak, the predominant memory of his long-time friend was his attitude, his outlook on life, and it was summed up in one key phrase: "Ain't it a pretty day."

"He'd say that if he had a misfortune," Peak stated. "If he missed a two-foot putt, 'Ain't it a pretty day,' he'd say or anything happened to him in his life, that was his attitude. He always loved each day."

Turlington suffered from an illness during his last years but didn't let that stop him from continuing his daily working tasks and still golfing with his friends. Turlington claimed the title of golf champion at Coharie Country Club for several years, but is probably better known for his keen business sense.

Carrying on the business begun by his father, Festus Turlington, in 1917, Turlington Lumber Co. remains a thriving Clinton business today.

Turlington raised his two sons in the family business as well and today the 83-year-old lumber company is run by Thomas Turlington Jr. and Bill Turlington.

According to Combs, that same business sense was reflected in the way Turlington carried out his duties as a councilman.

"A lot of times, he expected us to operate as a business here," said Combs. "He certainly brought that business sense to the council."

The late Turlington leaves behind his wife, Jean Calhoun; two daughters, Neale and Selma; his two sons; and six grandchildren.

He was 75 years old.
