After graduating from Angier High School in 1944, Mary Frances McLeod and W. A. Coats, Jr., were married on May 10, 1944 and after almost 44 years of life together, Mr. Coats passed away on April 19, 1988. Mrs. Coats was also a graduate of Hales Business College in Raleigh.

They were the owners of Coats Properties, which over the years substantially contributed to the growth and development of the town of Angier. Eastover Homes, North Hickory Homes, Plaza Self Storage, North Park Apartments, Angier Car Wash 1 & 2, Angier Plaza Shopping Center and Crestview Mobile Home Park are among the list of the commercial developments owned

by Mary and W. A. Coats.

Coats & Shelley Construction, for which Mrs. Coats was office manager and bookkeeper, built other commercial properties across the state as well as in Virginia and South Carolina. Mrs. Coats was an organizer of several bus trips to U.S. destinations for the pleasure of Angier residents. She taught ceramic classes from her home in earlier years, was a secretary and bookkeeper for Electric Sales and Service.

An active member of Angier Baptist Church, choir member and Sunday School teacher, she was also in the Women's Missionary Union as a Circle leader and Girl's Auxiliary leader. She was Rotary Club president, a board member of BB&T Bank in Angier and Backers Club member of the North Carolina Theatre and Angier Chamber of Commerce member.
